 I sell four head of horses ten cattle twenty seven head of hogs. Also all my
 household & kitchen furniture by tools and plantation utensils and
 crop of every kind whatsoever so have and to hold the said Negroes & all
 and every other part of the above mentioned property to the only use and
 behoof of the said John Applewhite his heirs or assigns forever and their
 heirs against the said John Applewhite for himself & his heirs the aforesaid property to the said John
 Applewhite & heirs against the lawful claim of the said William & his heirs against
 all & every other person or persons will warrant and for use of the said presents for
 witness whereof the said William Applewhite hath hereunto set his hand and affixed
 his seal the day and year first above written

This Indenture made this 8th day of September One thousand seven
 hundred & ninety six Between Drewry Warren & Jane Warren his wife
 of the county of Surry of the one part & James Simmons of the county of
 Southampton of the other part Witnesseth that the said Drewry Warren
 & Jane Warren for and in the consideration of the sum of twenty seven pounds
 of good and lawful money of Virginia to them in hand paid on or before the undersig-
 ned day of the said September the receipt whereof we the said Drewry Warren
 & Jane his wife doth here by acknowledge hath granted bargained & sold
 granted & confirmed into the said James Simmons to his heirs and assigns
 one certain tract or parcel of land containing fifty one
 half acres lying in Southampton county it being my being my
 part of a tract of land belonging to David Camblins decd con-
 taining one hundred and fifty one acres & half more or less and bound
 as follows (to wit) Beginning at a pine in the white meadow in
 South & Jones line N 2 3/4 W 26 1/2 pole up to a small branch thence along John Warner line
 N 87 1/2 W 50 pole to a dead pine then N 74 W 14 pole to a oak thence N 4 1/2
 W 10 1/2 pole to a Hickory a corner of the said land then N 1 W 5 pole to a
 Hickory in John Randalls line thence along Randalls line N 12 East 9 pole to a
 pine then N 1 W 7 1/4 pole to a pine then N 87 East 36 pole to a pine in David
 Camblins line then along Camblins line N 87 East 38 pole to a pine then
 N 87 East 14 1/2 pole to a Spanish oak then N 87 East 70 pole to a red oak
