behalf of the said John Applewhite his heirs or assigns forever and bind  
William Applewhite for himself & his heirs the aforesaid property to the said John  
Applewhite & heirs against the lawfull claim of the said William & his heirs again  
all & every other person or persons will warrant and forever affix by these presents In  
witness whereof the said William Applewhite hath hereunto set his hand and affixed  
his seal the day and year first above written

This Indenture made this 8<sup>th</sup> day of September One thousand seven  
hundred & ninety six Between Dredy Warren & Jane Warren his wife  
of the county of Surry of the one part & James Simmons of the county of  
Southampton of the other part witnesseth that the said Dredy Warren  
& Jane his wife for and in the consideration of the sum of twenty seven pounds  
of good and lawful money of Virginia to them in hand paid in or before the sealing  
of this Indenture the receipt whereof we the said Dredy Warren  
& Jane his wife doth hereby acknowledge and grant to the said James Simmons  
& confirmed into the said James Simmons to his heirs and assigns  
a certain tract or parcel of land containing fifty three  
half acres lying in Southampton county it being by me being my  
part of a tract of land belonging to Hattie Lambards deed con-  
taining one hundred and forty one acres & half more or less and bounded  
on a post road (to west) Beginning at a pine in the White Meadow line  
Blunt's corner No. 32 with 6 pole up a small branch then along John Moore line  
No. 87 West 50 pole to a dead pine then N. 74 West 17 pole to a red oak thence 46  
West 10 1/2 pole to a Hickory a corner of the P. land then N. 7 West 5 pole to a  
Hickory in Ann Randal's line then along Randal's line N. 76 East 36 pole to a pine in the  
spine then N. 7 West 44 pole to a pine then N. 57 East 36 pole to a pine in the  
Scarborough's line then along Scarborough's line N. 50 East 38 pole to a pine then  
N. 76 East 14 pole to a Spanish oak then N. 53 east 70 pole to a red oak
