This Indenture tripartite made this eleventh day of February the year
 of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty four between Annanias Randall
 of the first part Temperance Person widow and relict of Philip Person deceased of the
 second part and Thomas Turner of the third part all of the parish of St Luke and county
 of Southampton. Whereas the said Philip Person died by his last will and testament
 duly proved in the court of the said county gave & devised to his wife the said
 Temperance Person (part to their presents) one third part of the slaves whereof he should die
 seized and possessed and whereas a marriage is intended to be solemnized between the
 said Annanias and the said Temperance and it is agreed between the said
 two last mentioned parties that if the said Marriage shall take effect
 that he the said Annanias Randall shall have possession and enjoy the
 use labors and profits of the slaves aforesaid and their increase so advised
