to the said Temperance Person for & during the term of her natural life and no longer so as not to deprive the said Temperance Person of her equal benefit of the labour of the said slaves in the lifetime of said Annanias Randall and she the said Temperance shall have power by her last will and testament or otherwise to give devise or dispose of the revision of the slaves aforesaid to all or any ~~any~~ of the children born of the said Temperance by the said Annanias in such manner as she the said Temperance shall think proper and for want of such children to such other person or persons as she may choose by such writings as aforesaid. Now this Indenture therefore witnesseth that as well for the making the said agreement good and effectual and of the said intended marriage as also for and in consideration of the sum of five shillings by the said Thomas Gunner to the said Annanias Randall in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged he the said Annanias doth hereby for himself his heirs executors and administrators covenant promise and agree to and with the said Thomas Gunner his heirs executors & admott^{rs} that notwithstanding the said intended marriage shall take effect that the said Temperance shall and may at any time hereafter either by her last will and testament or otherwise give devise or dispose of the slaves herein before mentioned or ~~described~~ and their increase just to the child or children that may be born of the said marriage or to any or either of them and for want of such to any other person or persons or for any other use intent or purpose whatsoever and that he the said Annanias shall and will permit and suffer such will to be duly proved by the executors that may be named therein and present to be obtained thereof as usual provided nevertheless and it is the true intent & meaning of these presents that such devise request or other conveyances shall not take effect until after the decease of the said Annanias Randall but that the said Annanias Randall shall and may have hold use and enjoy the said slaves and their increase herein before particularly described for and during the term of his natural life anything herein before contained to the contrary notwithstanding that he the said Annanias his heirs executors and admott^{rs} shall not nor will at any time or times hereafter do commit or suffer or cause to be done committed or suffered any act or thing whatsoever whereby the said Temperance shall or may be frustrated or hindered from the making or executing such last will and testament or other conveyances for the giving, devising or conveying the revision of the slaves so as aforesaid described according to the true intent and meaning of these presents.
