This Indenture made this eleventh day of September in the year
of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety six between Thomas
Giffard of the county of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one
part and Mary Harris of the county and state aforesaid of the other
part. Witnesseth that the said Thomas Giffard for and in considera-
tion of the sum of thirty pounds to him in hand paid by the said
Mary Harris the receipt whereof is acknowledged and have by these presents
bargained sold and confirmed unto the said Mary Harris her heirs &
assigns forever a certain tract or dividend of Land situate lying
and being in the county aforesaid containing by Estimation ninety
acres be there some more or less and bounded as follows To wit
Beginning at a white oak on the north side of Jacobs Branch running
North thirty six degrees west one hundred and twenty pole to a corner oak
in south swamp then south through the various courses of the said swamp
south seventy two degrees West twenty nine pole to a corner white oak on the
south side of said swamp then south ten degrees West eighty four pole to a
corner white oak then south thirty seven degrees east twenty two pole to a
corner white oak then south sixty degrees east twenty two pole to a corner
white oak on the North side of Jacobs branch then down a line of marked trees in the
edge of the meadows of the said branch North eighty four degrees East sixty
six pole to a pine then North seventy four degrees East twenty pole to a pine
then down the various courses of the said branch to the first station with the ap-
partenances thereunto belonging to her the said Mary Harris her heirs and as-
signs forever To have and to hold the said parcel of Land with all
& singular the appurtenances thereunto belonging to her the said Mary Harris
as of free and the said Thomas Giffard doth for him self his heirs &
assigns agree to & with the said Mary Harris her heirs & assigns
that he will supply the said bargain'd Land & premises and every
