articles of
agreement

Articles of agreement made and entered into this twenty seventh day of February
in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety six. Between Leibulow
Lewis, Benjamin Lewis, Elizabeth Butts, James Butts (in right of his wife Fanny)
Arthur Turner (in right of his wife Harry) Levi Rochelle (in right of his wife Sarah,
Joseph Gray Blunt (in right of his wife Rebecca), and William Simmons (in right
of his wife Jane) Witnetheth That Whereas Benjamin Lewis died late of the
county of Southampton by his last will and testament duly recorded
in the said county court of Southampton did amongst other devices in his
will contained direct that his Mary should have the use of Sunday negroes
& slaves and other personal estate during her life and at her death the said
negroes and other estate so lent his said wife should be equally divided between
his children namely Leibulow, Benjamin, Elizabeth, Fanny, Harry, Sarah,
Rebecca & Jane and where as the said Mary Lewis hath departed this
life so that in virtue of said will the parties above named have joined
to make divisions of the said negroes and other estate amongst them-
selves in the following manner. To Leibulow Lewis for his share of the
said negroes. Rob. 2 horses 56 Gallons Brandy & twenty three barrels
corn £100 as also his full share of the said personal estate and to Benjamin
Lewis negro & William 2 horses. Hags 56 Gallons Brandy & 20 barrels £100 as
also his full share of the said personal estate to James Butts in right
of his wife Fanny negroes Rose, Dick, Harry 1 horse 56 Gallons of Brandy
23 barrels as also his full share of the said personal estate. To Arthur
Turner in right of his wife Harry 56 Gallons Brandy 23 barrels.
