to Bell

This Indenture made this eighth day of December in the year of our Lord  
 one thousand seven hundred & ninety five between Cooper Williams and wife Christian  
 of Battavaria in Wash County of the one part and James Bell of Southampton  
 County of the other part Witnesseth that the Said Cooper Williams and wife for  
 in consideration of the sum of five pounds fourteen shillings and one half  
 Penny of Virginia to them in hand paid by the Said James Bell the receipt  
 whereof the Said Cooper Williams and wife doth hereby acknowledge  
 they the Said Cooper Williams and wife hath granted bargained & sold al  
 enfeoffed and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell al enfeoffed  
 and confers unto the Said James Bell his heirs and assigns forever a  
 certain tract or parcel of land containing nine and half acres be the same more  
 less situate lying and being in the County of Southampton and lying on the North  
 side of Kelly's road and bounded as follows beginning at a corner pine  
 Standing in Said Bell's line thence S $\frac{1}{2}$  E $\frac{1}{2}$  67 poles to a corner pine near the road in  
 the Black Branch thence along the said road to said Bell's line thence up  
 Bell's line to beginning pine containing 9 $\frac{1}{2}$  acres and also all trees woods  
 unar woods common of pasture profits commodities advantages  
 Emoluments & hereditaments whatsoever to the said tract or parcel of  
 land above mentioned belonging or any wise appertaining even or  
 upon the same growing happening or arising and also the livery  
 and reversions remainder and remainders unto & uses of the Said premises  
 above mentioned and of every part and parcel thereof and also all the  
 estate right title Interest claims and demand whatsoever of the Said Cooper Williams  
 and wife of in and to the said premises and every part thereof to have and to hold all and  
 singular the said premises above mentioned and every part and parcel thereof with the  
 appurtenances unto the said James Bell his Heirs and Assigns to the only proper use  
 and behoef of the said James Bell his Heirs and Assigns forever and the said Cooper Wil-  
 liams and wife for them and their Heirs the said tract of land and every part thereof against  
 themselves and their Heirs and against all and every other Person and Persons whatsoever to  
 the said James Bell his Heirs and Assigns shall and will warrant and forever defend
