This Indenture made this fourteenth Day of October Anno Dom: 1796 Between Edwin Gray James Wilkinson Samuel Killo Benjamin Blunt Thomas Ridley Benjamin Ruffin Robert Goodwin and John Taylor Gentlemen Trustees as here in allit mentioned of the one part and William Crichton of the County of Southampton of the other part Witnesseth that whereas an act of the general Assembly of Virginia passed December 7<sup>th</sup> 1791 intituled an act to establish certain Towns and other purposes hath enacted that ten Acres of Land adjoining the court House of the County of Southampton the property of Joseph and William Coth should be and was there by vested in Edwin Gray James Wilkinson Samuel Killo Benjamin Blunt Thomas Ridley Benjamin Ruffin Robert Goodwin and John Taylor gentlemen trustees to be by them or a majority of them said of into lots of one half acre each with convenient streets and establish a town by the name of Jerusalem and where as the said act has further directed that the said trustees or a majority of them should proceed sell the said lots at public auction for the best price that could be had for the same and hath empowered the said trustees to convey the same to the purchasers thereof in <sup>or</sup> upon certain conditions which may be more particularly known by a reference to the said act now This Indenture witnesseth that the said Edwin Gray James Wilkinson Sam Killo Benjamin Blunt Thomas Ridley Benjamin Ruffin Robert Goodwin &
