This Indenture made this fourteenth of October Anno Dom one thousand seven hundred and ninety six between Edwin Gray James Wilkinson Samuel Kells Benjamin Blunt Thomas Ridley Benjamin Ruffin Robert Goodwyn and John Taylors gentlemen trustees as herein after mentioned of the one part and John Crichlow of the county of Southampton of the other part; Witness that whereas an act of the general assembly of Virginia passed December ye seventh, one thousand seven hundred and ninety one entitled an act to establish certain towns, and for other purposes hath enacted that ten acres of land adjoining the courthouse of the county of Southampton the property of Joseph and William Scott should be and was thereby vested in Edwin Gray James Wilkinson Samuel Kells Benjamin Blunt Thomas Ridley Benjamin Ruffin Robert Goodwyn and John Taylor gentlemen trustees to be by them or a majority of them laid off into lots of an half acre each with convenient streets and established a town by the name of Jewsalem And whereas the said act hath further enacted that the said trustees or a majority of them should proceed to sell the said lots at public auction for the best price that could be had for the same and hath empowered the said trustees to convey the same to the purchaser
