This Indenture made this 21 Day of November in the year of our Lord Christ 1796 Between Anne Johnson of the county of Southampton & state of Virginia of the one part and Benjamin Johnson of the county & state aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth ^{that} the said Anne Johnson for & in consideration of the sum of 20 Pounds Current money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Benjamin Johnson the receipt whereof the said Anne Johnson doth hereby acknowledge she the said Anne Johnson have granted bargained sold aliened & confirmed & by these presents doth grant bargain & sell alien & confirm unto the said Benjamin Johnson his heirs and assigns forever all my right & title that I have to the Lands whereon I now live & bounded as follows (to wit) Beginning at pine standing on Barrows road a corner of Joshua Johnsons thence along the said Johnsons line to a white Oak standing on the North Side of Buckhorn Swamp, a corner of said Johnsons thence down the edge of the low grounds of said swamp to a white oak a corner of Arthur Fosters thence along the said Fosters line to Barrows road thence along the said Barrows road to the beginning And also the reversion and reversions remainder and remainders unto issues and services of the said premises and every part and parcel thereof and all the estate right title interest claim and demand whatsoever of her the said Ann Johnson of in and to the said Tract of land and every part thereof To have & to hold the said tract or parcel of land and all and singular the premises above mentioned and every part and parcel thereof with the appurtenances unto the said Benjamin Johnson his heirs and assigns forever To the only proper use & behoof of the said Benjamin Johnson his heirs and assigns forever and the said Anne Johnson for her self and her heirs the said seal Tract or piece of Land and premises and every part thereof, against herself & her heirs and against all and every person whatsoever to the said Benjamin Johnson his heirs and assigns shall and warrant and forever defend by these presents In witness whereof the said Anne Johnson hath hereunto set her hand & seal the Day and year first above written
