 on the south side of Sarripin swamp in the County of Southampton

 thence up the main run of said swamp to a Cypress standing just above the  
 mill dam near the run of said swamp thence near Southwest to a fork in road  
 oak thence near south west to a walnut tree thence near South East to a small  
 Hickory on James Lancaster line at the old Road thence down the said Road  
 to the Bridge first begun at to gether with all my right Title & claim to an  
 order of Southampton Court first build & rebuild from time to time as they  
 the said James Lancaster & Samuel Bailey or their Heirs may think proper  
 a grist mill or mills on the Lands above mention'd & also all my right to an  
 acre of Land decreed to me by the Court of Southampton, which will more fully ap-
