This Indenture made this 9th day of January in the year of our Lord 1797
 Between Carter Womack of the county of Halifax & State of North Carolina
 on the part of William Wright of the county of Southampton of the same
 of Virginia of the other part witnesseth that the said Carter Womack for and in consider-
 ation of the sum of one hundred & twenty eight pounds current money of Virginia
 to him in hand paid, by the said William Wright the receipt whereof, the
 said Carter Womack doth hereby acknowledge to be fully satisfied and paid
 hath bargained sold alienated released & confirmed and doth by these presents
 fully & absolutely grant, sell & confirm unto the said William Wright his heirs
 and assigns forever, one certain tract or parcel of land containing by estima-
 tion, 85 acres being the same more or less lying & being in the sd county of South-
 ampton & bounded as followeth, Beginning at a pine in Francis Branches
 line, thence along the said Branches line to Elizabeth Gillars line then
 along
