claiming the the same by form or under him the Carter Wommack, clear of all Deeds,
Wills Mortgages right of Dower or any other incumbrances whatsoever, to the only proper
use and behoof of him the said William Wright his heirs and assigns forever and the
said Carter Wommack for him self and his heirs doth further promise, to, and with the
said William Wright his heirs and assigns, that the right and title of the said Land
& premises, and of every part thereof against all and every person and persons he will war-
rant and forever by these presents defend unto the said William Wright his heirs
and assigns forever - In witness whereof the said Carter Wommack hath hereunto

This Indenture made this 19th Day of October in the year of our Lord 1796 be-
tween Jacob Darden Junr of Southampton County & State of Virginia trustee for the
Creditors of James Scoggins (as will appear by a Deed in trust to him for that purpose
made by the said James Scoggins bearing date the 15th day of March 1796) of the one
part and William Cooper of the town of Marseborough, North Carolina of the
other part, Witness, that the sd Jacob Darden Junr for & in consideration
