This Indenture made this 17th Day of December, in the year of our Lord United 1796 Between Kichen Turner of the county of Southampton of the one part, & George Jey of the said county of Southampton of the other part Witnesseth that the said Kichen Turner for and in consideration of the sum of 300 Dollars to him in hand paid by the said George Jey the receipt thereof the said Kichen Turner doth hereby acknowledge to be fully satisfied and paid hath lawfully gained, sold Alien's, released and confirmed and doth by these presents, fully and absolutely, grant, sell, and confirm, unto the said George Jey his heirs and Assigns forever, one certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the said county of Southampton, on the North side of the West swamp, Containing 120 acres be the same more or less and bounded as followeth Beginning at a gum by the side of Watbets branch in Joshua Clouds line, thence a long the said Clouds line, South 30 Degrees West 44 poles to a red oak, a corner of the said Clouds and Benjamin Blunt junr's lines thence a long the said Blunt's line to a small pine by the side of the pasture branch, thence North 60 Degrees West 106 poles to a red Oak thence south seventy degrees West 23 poles to a gum thence North 35 Degrees West 55 poles to a red Oak thence North 5 Degrees East 62 poles to a Maple, by the side of the south West fork of Watbets branch thence along the various courses, of the branch, to the Beginning To have and to hold the said Land and premises, together with all its appurtenances thereto belonging, or in any wise appertaining, together with all its privileges, to the only proper use and behoof of him the said George Jey his heirs & assigns forever, free from the Cl, hindrance, or incumbrance of him the said Kichen Turner his heirs and assigns or any other person or persons claiming the same by force, or under him the said Kichen Turner clear of all Debts or Mortgages or any other
