of the other part, both of Southampton County & of the parish of Holloway, Wiltshire
that he the said Benjamin Drew for & in consideration of the sum of 100 pounds to him
in hand paid, the ^{right} whereof he the said Benj^m Drew doth hereby acknowledge, & ought
and shall the said Thos Wood, his heirs, Executors, & Executrixes & each & every of them, have
bargained, sold, granted, aliened & released & by these presents do bargain, sell, grant, alien &
lease unto him the said Thos Wood his heirs and assigns, and that tract or parcel of land
lying and being the County of Southampton and parish of Holloway which the said Drew
purchase of James Only and Mary his wife and John Hix Bellamy his wife contain-
ing by estimation 2 1/2 acres be the same more or less bounded to the
