The Commonwealth of Virginia to Benj: Blunt & Robert Habry Gentlemen Justices
of the peace of Southampton county greeting. Whereas Willis R Holladay and Mary his wife
by their certain inventur of bargain and sale bearing date 25th Day February in the year of
Christ 1796 have sold and Conveyed unto Wm. Biddle the fee simple estate of and in forty three
and one fourth acres of land lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton & parish
of Saint Luke and whereas the said Mary cannot conveniently travel the Court of our said
county to make acknowledgement of the conveyance aforesaid, therefore we do give unto you or
any two of you power to receive the acknowledgement which the said Mary shall be willing to make
before you of the conveyance aforesaid contained in the said Indenture which is hereto annexed &
command you to go personally to the said Mary and receive her acknowledgement of the same and
examine her privately and apart from her said husband whether she has executed the said indenture
fully and voluntarily without his persuasion or threat and whether the said Indenture should be
Recorded in the Court of our said County of Southampton and when you have examined
her as aforesaid and taken her acknowledgement of the said indenture that you distinctly
and openly certify as thereof in our said Court under your hand and seals returning to us also
the said indenture and this writing, witness Samuel Kells clerk of our said court at his office the
16th Day of September 1796 & in the 20th year of our foundation. — — —

and freely and voluntarily relinquished her right of recovery — — —

certify the Justices of the said county court under our hands and seals this 6th day of
May 1796
