This Indenture made this twelfth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand four hundred & ninety six between John Gilliam and Mary his wife of the County of Southampton & state of Virginia of the one part and Jacob Barrett of the County & state aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that the said John Gilliam and Mary his wife for and in consideration of the sum of eighty four pounds current money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Jacob Barrett before the sealing & Delivering of these presents the receipt whereof is acknowledged to be fully satisfied and paid hath granted Bargained and sold and doth by these presents Grant Bargain sell and confirm unto the said Jacob Barrett a tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County aforesaid situated in the lower end of Southampton containing by estimation eighty acres be the same more or less and bounded as followeth

Beginning at a pine a corner of William Bryant's Land in the old County line hence along the said County line to a small gum in a slash thence up the said slash to a pine in the head of the slash a corner thence to a couple of pines in Sam Everitt's line thence along the said line to a pine a corner in Sam Everitt's line thence along the said line to the beginning it being part of a Patent granted to Robert Gilliam in the year one thousand seven hundred & forty nine

To have and to hold the said Land and premises thereon or thereto with the appurtenances unto the said Jacob Barrett his heirs & assigns forever and also the reversion and reversions Remainder or remainders rents and services of all and singular the said premises and also the right title Interest property claim and demand of them the said John Gilliam and Mary his wife for themselves their heirs Executors &c doth covenant grant and agree to and with the said Jacob Barrett that the said Jacob Barrett his heirs Executors &c shall and lawfully may from hence forever hereafter quietly & peaceably may have hold occupy possess & enjoy the said land and premises above mentioned and sufficiently save & keep harmless from all trouble & incumbrance whatsoever by them the said John Gilliam & Mary his wife their heirs Executors &c or any other person or persons whatsoever will warrant & forever defend the witness whereof the said John Gilliam & Mary his wife hath hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and year above mentioned
