and my covenant to and with the said Humphry Drury his heirs assigns that they and each & every of them will forever warrant & defend title of the Land Premises hereby intended to be sold & conveyed to the said Humphrey Drury his heirs and assigns against the claim or claims of them the said Amos Harris James Mason & Catherine his wife or either of them their or either of their heirs and also against the claims of all and every other person or persons whatsoever.
