This Indenture made this twenty seconde day of November in the year of
 Lord Christ 1796 between Jacob Darden junr of Southampton County, & State of Virginia
 of the one part & John Crosplen Senr of the County and State aforesaid of the other part
 Witnesseth, that he the said Jacob Darden for & in consideration of the sum of
 Twenty one pounds 5/11¹/₂ to him in hand paid by the said John Crosplen Before the
 infeasings & Delivery, of these presents, the receipt whereof the s^r. Jacob Darden doth
 hereby acknowledge, & himself to be therewith fully satisfied & contented & said hath bar-
 gained & released & forever quit claim & by these presents doth release, quit claim &
 forever confirm unto him the s^r. John Crosplen his heirs & assigns forever a
 certain tract of Land lying in Southampton County & on the West of the
 Cypress Swamp containing Fifty acres more or less it being the Land & plantation
 whereon the s^r. Crosplen now lives, & the balance of the tract granted to Elisha
 Darden by him s^r. Crosplen as will appear by a Mortgage Deed for the same
 bearing Date the fourteenth Day of Feb^y. 1786 To have & to hold the
 Land plantation & appurtenances to him the s^r. John Crosplen his heirs and
 forever, And he the s^r. Jacob Darden for him self his heirs & assigns and
 Admors will warrant and for ever defend the right and title of the
 s^r. Land & appurtenances against all & every person or persons what-
 ever laying claim to or demanding the sum or any part thereof by
 virtue of the aforesaid Mortgage Deed. In Witness whereof he the
