This Indenture made this fifteenth day of May Anno Domini 1797  
Between John Simmons and Lucy his wife of the parish of Kettleway County  
of Southampton of the one part; and Benjamin Simmons of the aforesaid  
parish & County of the other part. We therefore that John Simmons and Lucy  
his wife for in consideration of the sum of one hundred & fifty pounds current  
money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Benjamin Simmons  
at or before the enscaling and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof  
the said John Simmons and Lucy his wife doth hereby acknowledge and  
thereof acquit & discharge the s<sup>d</sup> Ben<sup>g</sup> Simmons, Heath, <sup>granted</sup> bargain and sold & with  
by these presents grant bargain and sell unto the said Benjamin Simmons  
his heirs and assigns all that tract or parcel of Land Situate lying & being  
in the aforesaid parish of Kettleway & County of Southampton containing by esta-  
mation four hundred & fifty acres be the same more or less and bounded  
follows Beginning at W<sup>m</sup> Simmons's corner tree on the ready branch  
from thence along the said branch to Frances Clements line thence along  
the s<sup>d</sup> Clements to Miles Bay's line from thence along the said bay's line to  
Mason Simmons's line from thence along the said Simmons's line to the  
Goodwyn's line from thence along the said Goodwyn's line to the Beginning  
with the reversion & reversions remainders & remainders rents Issues &  
Profits thereof & also all the Estate right title property claim & Demand whatsoever  
of the said John Simmons & Lucy his wife; To have & to hold  
the said tract or parcel of land & all other the premises hereby granted  
bargain'd & sold mentioned or intended to be hereby bargain'd or sold  
every part or parcel thereof, with every appurtenance, unto the said  
Ben<sup>g</sup> Simmons his heirs and assigns forever: And the said John Simmons  
& Lucy his wife for themselves and their heirs the said tract or parcel of  
Land & premises unto the s<sup>d</sup> Benjamin Simmons his heirs and assigns
