This Indenture made this twelfth day of December in the year of 1796 Between James Drew of the County of Sutton State of Virginia of the one part & Harris Johnson of the aforesaid County and State of the other part Witneseth, that the aforesaid James Drew for and in consideration of the sum of fifteen pounds Current money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the aforesaid Harris Johnson the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge hath granted, bargained, sold, alien'd Release'd & confirm'd; and by these presents for himself & his heirs doth grant, bargain, sell, alien, release, and confirm unto the said Harris Johnson his heirs & assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Land lying & being in the County aforesaid & bounded as follows (to wit) Beginning at a pine in Humphrey Diersey's Line thence a South course to a pines branch to a pine thence down the various Run of the sd Branch to three Ashes thence a North course along Drew's old Line to a Gum in the fork Branch thence up the various Run of the fork Branch to a Dead Old Line thence along the old Line to the new Line to a black post & from thence to the Beginning containing by estimation thirty acres be the same more or less with all houses, Woods ways Waterways & therunto belonging in any way appurtenances also the Eversion and
