This Indenture made this twenty fifth of February in the year of our Lord one
 thousand seven hundred ninety seven Between Arthur Whitehead & Sally his Wife of
 the County of Lorton & State of Virginia of the one part & Luke Sibson of the County
 of Albemarle of the other part Witnesseth that the said Arthur Whitehead
 Sally his Wife for and in consideration of the sum of ten Dollars ten shillings to
 them in hand paid before the sealing & delivery of these presents the receipt
 whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Arthur Whitehead Sally his wife
 to be fully satisfied and paid hath granted Bargained & sold & with by these
 presents Grant bargain & sold unto the said Luke Sibson one tract or parcel of Land
 lying & being in the County aforesaid Situated on the north of the highway
 containing by estimation ten acres & one half be the the same more or less
 bounded as follows (to wit) Beginning at a maple in the Branch between
 the sd. Whitehead and Miles Everett thence east a line of marked trees
 to the
