Know all men by these presents that I George Williams of the County of Solm & State of Virginia do in consideration of the sum of one hundred pounds lawfull money of this Commonwealth to me in hand paid by Charles Williams of Hertford County & State of North Carolina the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged and myself fully satisfied have Bargained sold & made over and conveyed unto the aforesaid Charles Williams and his heirs forever a Negro Woman named Luv and boy of her name named Rega & Girl named Fillis W. RICE who hold the aforesaid bargain these Negroes to the only proper use and behoof of the aforesaid Charles Williams and his heirs forever that I the said George Williams do acquit my self of the said Negroes and their increase and do put the sd. Charles Williams and his heirs in peaceable & quiet possession of them that I the said George Williams my heirs and assigns do quit all Right Title to the said Negroes & do warrant and defend the aforesaid bargain against the lawfull Claims of any person or persons whatsoever as witness hereof I the said George Williams have hereunto set my hand and seal this 24th day of March in the year of our Lord 1797
