

This Indenture made this eleventh day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven; Between Jane Riddley of the County of Southampton in the one part and William Wright of the said County of the other part witnesseth that for and consideration of the sum of five pounds current money of Virginia & in the said Jane Riddley in hand paid the weight whereof she the said Jane Riddley doth hereby acknowledge & therefrom doth full acquit and discharge him the said William Wright his heirs & assigns by these presents as also for
