This Indenture made the 22^d day of March in the year of our Lord 1797 and in the year of the Commonwealth, Between George Williams of Southampton County State of Virginia of the one part and Charles Williams Sheriff for the State of North Carolina of the other part Witnesseth that the said George Williams in consideration of the sum of one hundred pounds lawful money of this Commonwealth, to him in hand paid by the said Charles Williams as or before the executing & Delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold unto the said Charles Williams his heirs and Assigns a certain tract of land containing 90 Acres the property of the said George Williams Beginning at the Mouth of the Saver's Lane branch where it empties into the Cyphers Swamp, running up the said branch into the Branch Lane branch up the small branch up the said branch a south course to the mouth of a small branch a south course to the Virginia line thence along the Virginia line an east course to a pine at the N.
