in the year of our Lord Christ, one thousand seven hundred and  
sixty seven, Between us the undersigned his wife, of the  
County of Southampton Estate of Virginia of the one part, and  
John Williams of the same County & State of the other part  
to William Kello, Esq; that the said John Williams his wife  
for, and in Consideration of the sum of one hundred and thirty  
pounds, current money of the state of Virginia, to them in hand  
paid by the said John Williams, at and before the signing sealing  
and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof the said John  
Kello and Elizabeth his wife, doth hereby acknowledge, and them  
selves therewith fully satisfied, contented & paid, have bargained  
and sold, and by these presents doth hereby bargain, sell, let, and  
enforce forever convey unto the said John Williams his heirs  
and assigns, a certain plantation Tract or parcel of Land, lying and being  
situated in the County of Southampton Estate of Virginia aforesaid  
and bounded as follows (to wit) Beginning at a cedar tree  
tree of Benjamin Williams's & son Jacob Barnes's line, thence  
a straight line of marked trees to a branch, thence leaving said  
the branch, following said Williams's line to a little way down  
thence down the east of the said swamp to a black Gum standing  
on the South side of the said swamp, thence a south course or  
line of marked trees to a pine a corner tree in Joseph Kello's  
shelde a south east course to a hickory, a corner tree in Stephen  
son's line, thence a west course a line of marked trees to Jacob  
Barnes's line, thence the said Barnes line to the beginning, and  
by estimation seventy two and a half Acres, be the same more or less  
to be determined by surveyor with all houses, out houses, ways, waters, Brooks, Rivers  
mines minerals profits and commodities, thereunto belonging, or in any  
wise appertaining, with all the estates, rights, title, & interest, claim
