NOW all men by these presents that I John Gardner of Southampton County State of Virginia, for myself, my heirs and administrators do hereby nominate, Appoint, Authorize and empower, Jacob Carter Senr. of the County and State aforesaid as my certain and lawful attorney, to sell and dispose of all the land plantations & appurtenances which I hold and possess in this County, giving, granting and investing him said Jacob Carter with the same unrevoked, and absolute authority to grant a Deed for the same, as is in and containing, promising and agreeing to warrant, clear and acquit him the said Carter his heirs &c. from all damage or disadvantage whatsoever, which may accrue to him in consequence of making such a Deed, given under my hand and seal this sixteenth day of March Anno Domini 1797 &c. —
