This Indenture made this 14<sup>th</sup> day of January, in  
 the year of our Lord Christ, one thousand seven hundred and  
 ninety seven, Between Curren Scott and Ann his wife  
 of the County of Isle of Wight, of the one part, and James Irwin  
 of the County of Southampton of the other part, Witnesses  
 for and in consideration of the sum of twenty dollars current  
 money of Virginia, by the said James Irwin to the said  
 Curren Scott in hand paid, at or before the sealing and delivery  
 of these presents, the receipt whereof he the said Curren Scott  
 doth hereby acknowledge, and thereof acquit & discharge the said James  
 Irwin, his executors & administrators. They the said Curren Scott and his  
 wife have granted, bargained, sold, Aliened, conveyed, and confirmed  
 and by these presents do grant bargain, sell, alien, convey & confirm  
 unto the said James Irwin, his heirs, and assigns, one certain tract  
 or parcel of land, lying & being near the Town of Jerusalem, in the County  
 of Southampton, adjoining the Lot of William Richlow, the said Lot being  
 number twenty of the said Town of Jerusalem, and containing by esti-  
 mation one Acre, and more or less as follows to wit, beginning at the South West  
 corner of the said William Richlow's Lot (Numbered only) thence  
 along the road, to the sixteen degrees west, thirteen poles to William Richlow's  
 Corner, thence North sixty four degrees east twelve poles to the North East  
 Corner of said William Richlow's Lot thence to the beginning, and all the  
 buildings, fences, ways, waters, water courses, profits, annuities,  
 hereditaments, and appurtenances, to the same belonging, or in anywise  
 appertaining, and the reversion and reversions, remaines, profits, and  
 rents Issues & profits thereof, and all the estate rights, titles, interests  
 property, claims, demands, of them the said Curren Scott and Ann his  
 wife, of in and to the same, and every part and parcel thereof,
