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This INDENTURE made this eleventh day of November in the
year of our Lord, one thousand seven hundred and sixty six, between
John Scott and Nancy his wife of the County of Isle of Wight and
state of Virginia, of the one part, and Josiah Hicks of the County of
state of Southampton, of the other part witnesseth, that the said John
Scott & Nancy his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of forty three
pounds ten shillings current money of Virginia, to them now having been
by the said Josiah Hicks, at, and before the signing, sealing, and delivery
of these presents, the receipt whereof the said John Scott, and Nancy
his wife, doth hereby acknowledge, after themselves therewith fully satisfied,
contented and paid, hath bargained, sold, aliened, enfeoffed, continues
and by these presents doth hereby, bargain sell, alien, enfeoff and
forever convey, unto the said Josiah Hicks, his heirs & assigns, a
certain tract, piece or parcel of land, lying and being situated in the
said County of Southampton, on the North side of Mattaponi River, and
bounded as follows, beginning at a pine at the old church landing
on Mattaponi River in John Blidenwood's line, thence North 70° East 100
pole to a willow oak on the side of a slush, thence bending on the said
slush North 44° West 88 pole to a large pine & corner tree, thence in
a line of marked trees, South 51° West 39 pole, thence South 46° West 44
pole to the town line, thence the said town line South 26° East 40
pole to the south east corner of Joseph Holmes's lot, thence which
16° west 52 pole, to a sweet ginn on the bank of the River aforesaid
thence down the said River South 16° West 16 pole to the beginning,
containing by survey made by Wm. Wren, and laid down by a staled
forty five pole to the back, twenty eight & three quarter Acres, both
same, more or less. — Also two acres land adjoining two acres
soile, Scott to Doct: Josiah Dashiel, lying between the River and
the road leading out to broadwater, and bounded as follows (beginning
at the S. E. corner of Doct: Josiah Dashiel's lot), thence with
W. Scott 17 pole to a post, thence South 70° West 94 pole to the
Islands, thence down the Islands to the S. W. corner of Doct: Josiah
lot, South 23° East 18 pole, thence along the said Dashiel's line, West

laid down by staled forty five pole to the back, by William Wren
Surveyor the 20th of January 1797, and the above 28 1/4 Acres, though
of the same lot, devised to the said George Scott, by Doct: Josiah
Scott & William Scott, Together with all houses, out houses, gardens
waters and watercourses, woods, under woods, ellines and meadows
and all other the profits and benefits, and all other privileges thereto belong-
ing or in any wise appertaining. To have & to hold the
said bargained premises with every of the appurtenances unto the
said Josiah Hicks his heirs & assigns forever, with the reversion and
reversions, remainders and resumanders, rents & issues and profits there-
of, and every part and parcel thereof, with all the estates, rights & prop-
erty, claims, and demands, of them the said John Scott, and Nancy his wife
their heirs executors and administrators, to the only proper use and benefit
of the said Josiah Hicks, his heirs, and assigns forever. —
