Now all men by these presents that, that we Caim be of the
County of Solothorn and
firmly bound unto Josiah Wick of the County of Southampton, Con-
state of Virginia, in the just and full sum of five thousand pounds
Gold or silver money, agreeable to the present fine, to be paid
unto the said Josiah Wick, his certain attorney, his heirs Executors
or administrators or assigns, to the payment whereof, we do bind our-
selves, jointly and severally, our heirs, and several heirs, Executors
and Administrators, firmly by these presents, sealed with our seals, and
dated this Eleventh day of November 1796. —

The Condition of the above Obligation is such that whereas
the said Caim Scott hath sold and conveyed, unto the said Josiah
Wick, a certain tract or parcel of land, lying in the said County of
Southampton, adjoining the lands of John Mendenwood, and the town
of Jerusalem, as by Deed bearing even date with these presents, well
more fully appears, Also two Acres of land sold and conveyed in the
said deed, adjoining a certain lot, sold by him to Doct. Cashie, and
being situate in the south side of the main road leading out
from the said Town of Jerusalem to broad water, & situate imme-
diately from the said Town, except the Lot or Lots of one or two
acres, purchased of him by the said Doct. Cashie, & also of the
wife of the Caim Scott, shall voluntarily acknowledge her right
down, when thereunto requested, to the said Lands, according to
Law, and the said Caim Scott for him self, his heirs, and
administrators, shall at all times in any matter or cause
