gold or silver money, agreeable to the present fine sum, to be paid
unto the said Josiah Clegg, his certain attorney, his heirs Executors
or Administrators or Assigns, to the payment whereof we do bind our
selves, jointly and severally, our trust, and several heirs, Executors
and Administrators, firmly by these presents, sealed with our hands, and
dated this Eleventh day of November 1796. —

The Condition of the above obligation is such that whenever
the said C. Scott hath sold and conveyed, unto the said Josiah
Clegg, a certain tract or parcel of land, lying in the said County
of Southampton, adjoining the lands of John Blundewood, and the town
of Jerusalem, as by Deed bearing even date with these presents, will
more fully appear, also two acres of land sold and conveyed in the
same deed, adjoining a certain lot, sold by him to Robert Cashier, Esq;
and being situated on the south side of the main road leading out
from the said Town of Jerusalem to broad water, & situated immedi-
ately from the said Town, except the Lot or Lots of our two
acres, purchased of him by the said Robert Cashier, & Mrs. if the
wife of the said Scott, shall voluntarily acknowledge her right
doubt, when thus requested, to the said Lands, according to
Law, and the said C. Scott for himself, his heirs, executors
and administrators, shall at all times in any manner or cause
