with all and singular the premises herein granted or intended
to be granted, with the version & reversions, remaines and
remainers, rents, Issues & profits thereof, and every part and
parcel thereof To have and to hold, the aforesaid one hundred
& fifty Acres of land, with all the appurtenances, privileges
& commodities to the same belonging, or in any wise appertain-
ing to the said Althrigton Harvey, his heirs and assigns forever
and the said Henry Johnson, for himself, his heirs and assigns
I agree, stand with the said Althrigton Harvey, his heirs and
Assigns, that at the time of consenting hereof, he is the true
sole, and lawful owner, and is lawfully seized & possessed of
the same, and has in himself good right, full power and
able authority in manner aforesaid to convey the same
and that the said Althrigton Harvey, shall and may from thence
have and use at all times forever hereafter, by force and Virtue
of these presents, lawfully peacefully and quietly, have, hold
use occupy possess and enjoy all the above granted and bear-
granted premises, free and clear, freely and clearly, acquitted
discharged & discharged from all manner of former and other
gifts, grants, bargains sales, leases, mortgages, &c. &c. entails
rents, Dowers, Incumbrances, Incumbrances, &c. &c.
To wit, — Furthermore the said Henry Johnson doth
expressly covenant and bind himself, his heirs and assigns
and Assigns, to secure and defend the aforesaid one hundred & fifty Acres of land
with all the appurtenances to the said Althrigton Harvey, his heirs
& assigns, against the lawful claims of any person or persons what-
