To all whom these presents shall come, Whereas a
 certain Henry Johnson of the County of Southampton by
 his deed in trust bearing date the twenty third day of
 April, one thousand seven hundred and ninety six, did sell
 and convey unto Elizabeth Scott and to her heirs and assigns
 one certain messuage and tract of land situate lying and being
 in the County aforesaid, for the consideration and securing the
 payment of thirty one pounds fifteen Shillings, and Interest
 thereon, from the last day of November, one thousand seven
 hundred and ninety six, then lastly due to the said Elizabeth
 Scott from the said Henry Johnson, with a right or power of
 redemption, on the payment of the aforesaid sum & Interest to
 the said Elizabeth Scott, her heirs or assigns, and so hereat the
 said Henry Johnson, hath paid & satisfied, unto the said
 Elizabeth Scott, the aforesaid sum of thirty one pounds & fifteen
 Shillings, and the Interest due thereon to the date hereof. And
 know ye, that the said Elizabeth Scott, for the consideration
 aforesaid, have, and by these presents do receive, release, and
 forever quit claim, unto the said Henry Johnson, and to his
 heirs and assigns, all the right, title, Interest, claim or demand
 of her the said Elizabeth Scott, her heirs, executors, administrators
 and assigns, of in, and to the aforesaid tract or parcel of
 land mentioned to be conveyed, in and by the aforesaid deed
 in trust, herein before mentioned, and I do hereby acquit and
 discharge the said Henry Johnson, his heirs executors, and
 assigns, from the said debt and demand, with Interest
