This Indenture made this ninth day of February
in the year of our Lord, one thousand seven hundred &
ninety seven. Between Roger Reese and Randolph Reese
administrators &c. of the last Will and Testament of John
Reese Senr. dec'd. late of the County of Southampton of
the one part, and Rivers Reese of the said County of
Southampton of the other part, Witnesseth, that the said
Roger Reese and Randolph Reese, pursuant to the last Will &
Testament of the said John Reese dec'd. for and in consideration
of the sum of one hundred and seventy nine pounds six shillings
and eight pence, current money of Virginia, to them in hand paid
by the said Rivers Reese, the receipt whereof they the said Roger
Reese & Randolph Reese do hereby acknowledge. That the said Roger
Reese and Randolph Reese, administrators &c. hath granted, bar-
guined, sold, aliened and confirmed by these presents do grant
buy, sell, alien and confirm unto the said Rivers Reese, his
heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land, situate,
lying & being in the said County of Southampton his bounded
as follows, to wit. Beginning at the mouth of a branch, thence
along the said branch to the head No 18th west sixty six pole, thence
No 4th degrees west forty pole to the road, thence along the road
one hundred and twenty nine pole to a red oak. S. sixty three
degrees west twenty nine pole to a red oak. S. 64th degrees
west fifty one pole to a red oak in little Pocoman swamp
thence down the said swamp to the beginning, containing
by late survey one hundred and twenty six Acres, be the
same more or less, with all hays, woods, underwoods, tithes
profits, Commodities, advantages, hereditaments and appur-
tenances whatso ever to the said tract or parcel of land and
premises belonging, or in any wise appertaining, and also,
