This Indenture, made this sixteenth day of July, one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven, Between James Wilkinson of Southampton County of the one part, and Edmund Turner, of the County of the other part, Witneseth, that the said James Wilkinson for and in Consideration of the sum of one Dollar to him in hand paid by the said Edmund Turner, thereceipt whereof is hereby acknowledged thatt bargain, and sale, and by these presents do bargaine and sell unto the said Edmund Turner his heirs and assigns, a certain tract or piece of land, lying in the County of Southampton, in the parish of Saint Lukes, containing by estimation, eighty acres, be the same more or less, and bounded as followeth (viz) Beginning at a large white oak corner tree in Jacobs Branch, thence down the said branch, along a line of small trees, to an Ash, another corner, in another Branch, thence up the middle of the said Branch, along a line of new made trees, to a sweet Chestnut corner tree between said Wilkinson's father Father John Edmund Turner; from thence to the beginning; To have and to hold, the said land and premises with all the appurtenances thereto the said Edmund Turner, his heirs and assigns forever, and the said James Wilkinson, his heirs &c with all and singular the appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Edmund Turner free from the claim or claims of him the said James Wilkinson, his heirs &c and of all and every person or persons whatsoever, shall, will, and do warrant & defend the said premises, In witness whereof the said James Wilkinson, hath hereunto set his hand and seal, the day and year first above written —
