This Indenture, made this sixteenth of July, one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven, Between James Wilkinson of the County of Southampton, of the one part, and Edmund Turner, of the County of the other part, Witnesseth, that the said James Wilkinson for and in consideration of the sum of one Dollar to him in hand paid by the said Edmund Turner, the receipt of which is here by acknowledged, hath bargained, sold, aliened, conveyed, confirmed, released, quit, and by these presents do bargain and sell unto the said Edmund Turner, his heirs and assigns, a certain tract or parcel of land, lying in the County of Southampton, in the parish of Saint Lukes, containing by estimation, eighty acres, be the same more or less, and bounded as followeth (to wit) Beginning at a large white oak a corner tree in Jacobs Branch, thence down the said branch, along a line of marked trees, to an ash, another corner, in another Branch, thence up the middle of the said Branch, along a line of new marked trees, to a sweet gum a corner tree between said Wilkinson and John Suter doer. & Edmund Turner, from thence to the beginning; To have and to hold, the said land and premises with all the appurtenances unto the said Edmund Turner, his heirs and assigns forever, and the said James Wilkinson, his heirs & with all and singular the appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Edmund Turner, free from the claim or claims of him the said James Wilkinson, his heirs & of all and every person or persons whatsoever, shall, will, and do warrant & defend unto the said Edmund Turner, his heirs & assigns, whereof the said James Wilkinson, hath hereunto set his hand and seal, the day and year first above written
