This Indenture of three parts, made this 13th day of June in the year of Christ, one thousand seven hundred and ninety Seven, Between Benjamin Drew of the County of Southampton, and State of Virginia of the one part, William Allen of the County of Surry State of Virginia, of the other part, Samuel Kello of the County of Southampton, Captain in the State, of the third part, Whereas the said Benjamin Drew is jointly Indebted, to the said William Allen by a writing obligatory sealed with his Seal, and dated, the day and year aforesaid, in the just and full sum of Eight hundred, thirty eight pounds, fourteen Shillings & seven pence one farthing with lawful Interest thereon from the date aforesaid, and whereas the said Benjamin Drew is desirous that the said debt and Interest shall be punctually paid to the said William Allen, his heirs, executors, administrators or assigns, on demand according to the tenor and effect, of the writing obligatory before mentioned, without putting the said William Allen his heirs, executors, administrators or assigns to the trouble and expense of prosecuting a Suit at Common Law, or in Chancery to recover the same. Now this Indenture witnesseth that he the said Benjamin Drew, as well for and in Consideration of the before mentioned premises as for, and in Consideration of the sum of five Shillings to him in hand paid, by the aforesaid Samuel Kello, the receipt whereof the said Benjamin Drew doth hereby acknowledge, and thereof acquit his discharge the said Samuel Kello, his heirs, executors, administrators for ever, hath granted, bargained & sold and by these presents doth, grant, bargain & sell, release, confirm and confirm unto the said Samuel Kello, his heirs and assigns forever
