for and in consideration of the sum of thirty six pounds current money
of Virginia, which the said Edmund Byler, stands justly indebted
to the said Joseph Jones, Son of Lemuel Jones Esq. and to his heirs,
and to his assigns, and to him, and for and in consideration of
the further sum of five Shillings, like money, to the said Edmund
Byler, in hand paid by the said Joseph Jones, at and before the sealing
and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof the said Edmund
Byler, do hereby acknowledge, and thereof do acquit, and discharge the
said Joseph Jones, his heirs, executors, & assigns, he the said Edmund
Byler, have granted, bargained, & sold, and by these presents, do grant
bargain sell, and confirm, to the said Joseph Jones, and to his heirs
and assigns forever, a certain tract, division & parcel of Land, lying
and being in the parish of Littleway & County of Southampton, con-
taining by estimation fifty Acres, more or less, and bounded as follows
Beginning at the mouth of the middle branch, running up the
said branch to a pine, a mark & hee, from thence along a line of
marked trees to the Carless branch, then down the various courses of
the run of the said branch, to round Hill Swamp, then down the
