

This Indenture made this seventeenth day of August, in the year of our Lord, one thousand seven hundred, and ninety Seven, between Charles Cosby Williford of the County of Southampton of the one part, and Thomas Vaughan & Thomas Thomas Turner Esqrs. of William Vaughan decd. of the other part witnesseth that whereas the aforesaid Charles C. Williford stands justly indebted unto the aforesaid Thomas Vaughan & Thomas Turner, in the just and true sum of thirty Pounds, eleven shillings & six pence, being the interest & costs to the said Thos. Vaughan & Thos. Turner, This Indenture, Witnesseth that the said Charles C. Williford for, in the consideration of the sum of six shillings, by them the said Thomas Vaughan & Thos. Turner to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof he doth here by acknowledge & for the securing the payment of the aforesaid sum of thirty pounds, with Thos. C. Williford to the said Thos. Vaughan & Thomas Turner, he the said Charles C. Williford hath bargained & sold, and by these presents doth bargain & sell unto the said Thomas Vaughan & Thomas Turner, their heirs & assigns, four Leather beds of furniture, ten head of Cattle, twenty four head of hogs, two horses, my Rap of all kinds; Household and Kitchen furniture, plantation utensils &c. as also all any other property not herein mentioned, of what nature or kind soever, or wheresoever found - To have and to hold, the said bargained premises unto the said Thomas Vaughan & Thomas Turner, their heirs and assigns forever but upon this express proviso, intent and confidence for the said Charles C. Williford that they the said Thomas Vaughan & Thomas Turner, shall make sale of the aforesaid property, at any time after the first day of February next, embracing & out of the money arising from the sale thereof, first to pay and satisfy the aforesaid sum of thirty pounds with interest & costs as aforesaid, then to pay the balance of any unto the aforesaid Charles C. Williford, his heirs or assigns, and he the said Charles C. Williford for himself, his heirs or assigns doth grant, agree to and with the said Thomas Vaughan & Thomas Turner, that they shall have a just claim to the aforesaid property according to their agreement with him the said Charles C.
