The right Title of Elizabeth Gray in the said lands only fore prized & excepted shall and lawfully stand & forever defend by these presents, And the said Robert Wills for himself, his heirs executors, administrators & assigns, doth he is by covenant, promise & agree, to and with the said Jesse Williams Moore his heirs executors, administrators & assigns, that he the said Robert Wills his heirs or assigns, will well and truly pay, or cause to be paid, unto the said Jesse W. Moore, or to his heirs or assigns, the aforesaid sum of two hundred & twenty nine pounds, current money of Virginia with lawful interest, thereon growing due, on or before the twentieth day of August, next ensuing, and upon this Special Condition, the said Robert Wills, his heirs, or assigns, are to repay the said granted moneys, as fully and as amply, as though this deed had not been made.
