This INDENTURE made this second day of November in the year
of our Lord, one thousand seven hundred and ninety six, between Drury Harris,
Priscilla his wife of the County of Southampton, of the one part, & Henry Smith of the
said County, of the other part, witnesseth, that the said Drury Harris, &
Priscilla his wife, for and in Consideration of the sum of one hundred & Fifty
two pounds & nine pence, current money of Virginia, to them in hand paid by the
said Henry Smith, whereupon whereof they the said Drury Harris & Priscilla
his wife do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained, sold, alienated & confirmed
and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, & confirm, unto the said Henry Smith, his
heirs & assigns, the certain tract or parcel of land containing one hundred and
sixty seven & two thirds acres, together with the appurtenances, unto the said

Henry Smith, his heirs and assigns forever, also the profits of all Crops, and
vantage, hereditaments, and all the uses & execrations remainder, remain-
ders, rents, and services of the said Land, and premises and every part thereof, &
also, at the ^{same} ~~estate~~, ^{the} ^{same} ^{estate} ^{wherever}, of the said Drury Harris & Priscilla
his wife their heirs & execrators of us, and to the said land and premises above
mention'd, and every part thereof, with the appurtenances unto the said Henry
Smith, his heirs & assigns, to the only proper use & behoof of the said Henry
Smith, his heirs & assigns forever, and the said Drury Harris & Priscilla his
wife for themselves, and their heirs, the said land and premises, & every part
thereof, against themselves, and their heirs, are against all manner
person & persons whatever, to the said Henry Smith, his heirs and assigns,
