This indenture made this twenty first day of July
in the year of our Lord, one thousand seven hundred & ninety seven
between John Williamson, James Lucy, & Robert Mabey Commissioners appointed
by the County Court of Southampton at March Session, One thousand seven hundred
ninety six, to sell the estate of Sepe Cooper dec^d of the one part, Josiah Da.
shiel, of the County of Southampton of the other part witnesseth that the said
John Williamson, James Lucy, & Robert Mabey, Commissioners as aforesaid, agree
able to the said decree, of Southampton Court, and also for and in consideration of
the sum of Thirty seven pounds eighteen shillings, and six pence, money of Virginia
in hand paid by the said Josiah Dashiel, before the sealing, with delivery of
these presents, the receipt whereof the said Williamson, Lucy, & Mabey doth
hereby acknowledge, and thereof, are of every part thereof, dethoeverate, in
accord the said Josiah Dashiel his heirs, executors, & Administrators & every
of them by these presents, they the said Commissioners as aforesaid, hath partly
bargained & sold, and confirmed, and by these presents doth grant and assign
unto the said Josiah Dashiel, his heirs and assigns forever, one certain
tract or parcel of land, containing seventy five acres, be the same more
or less, lying and being in the said County of Southampton, and bounded
as followeth, by the banks of Newell's Creek, Henry Troope, and the lands
belonging to the estate of Amos Harris dec^d To have and to hold
the said seventy five acres (reserving unto Sarah Dashiel widow
next of Sepe Cooper dec^d howsoever in the said lands) without the
right & title which the said Sepe Cooper dec^d had in & to the said lands
at his death, together with all the appurtenances to the said lands belon-
ging, and the reversions and remainders, rents & issues & profits of
the same land & premises, hereby granted, or intended to be hereby
granted, and every part thereof — And also all the right title, interest
and claim, which he the said Sepe Cooper dec^d has in & to
the said land, and its appurtenances, To have and to hold the said
land & premises, hereby granted & confirmed & every part thereof
with the appurtenances unto the said Josiah Dashiel, his heirs and
assigns forever, free from the debts or his expenses of them the said Com-
missioners as aforesaid or the heirs of the said Sepe Cooper dec^d to the only
use & behoef him the said Josiah Dashiel his heirs and assigns
forever — M^t 1797 J^{uly} 21st whereof the said John Williamson, James
Lucy, & Robert Mabey commissioners as aforesaid, have hereunto set their
hands and seals the day & year first written —
