This Indenture made this twenty first day of February in the year of our Lord, one thousand seven hundred & ninety seven between John Williamson, James Lury, & Robert Maby Commissioners appointed by the County Court of Southampton, at March Session, One thousand seven hundred & ninety two, to sell the estate of Lepe Cooper dec^d of the one part, Josiah Dashield, of the County of Southampton of the other part **Witnesseth** that the said John Williamson, James Lury, Robert Maby, Commissioners as aforesaid, agreed to the said decree, of Southampton Court, and also for and in consideration of the sum of Thirty seven pounds sixteen shillings, Lawfull money of Great Britain in hand paid by the said Josiah Dashield, before the enrolling, and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof the said Williamson, Lury, & Maby jointly and severally acknowledge, and thereof, and of every part thereof, doth verily and truly acquit the said Josiah Dashield his heirs Executors, & Administrators & every of them by these presents, they the said Commissioners as aforesaid, hath granted bargained & sold, and confirmed, and by these presents doth grant and confirm unto the said Josiah Dashield, his heirs and assigns forever, one certain tract or parcel of land, containing seventy five Acres, be the same more or less, lying and being in the said County of Southampton, and bounded as followeth, by the lands of Edward Haid, Henry Thope, and the lands belonging to the estate of Annas Harris dec^d - To have and to hold this said seventy five Acres (reserving unto Josiah Dashield widow & relict of Lepe Cooper dec^d now deceased in the said Lands) with all the right & Title which the said Lepe Cooper dec^d had in & to the said land at his death, together with all the appurtenances to the said land belonging, and the reversions and remainders, rents Issues Profits of the same land & premises, hereby granted, or intended to be hereby granted, and every part thereof - And also all the right Title, Interest and claim, which he the said Lepe Cooper dec^d had in his life, in & to the said land, and its appurtenances, To have and to hold the said land & premises, hereby granted & confirmed & every part thereof with the appurtenances unto the said Josiah Dashield, his heirs and assigns forever, free from the toll or hindrance of them the said Commissioners as aforesaid or the heirs of the said Lepe Cooper dec^d to the only proper use and behoof him the said Josiah Dashield his heirs and assigns forever - **Witnesseth** whereof the said John Williamson, James Lury, and Robert Maby, Commissioners as aforesaid, hath hereunto set their hands and seals the day & year first written -
