This Indenture made this twentieth day of September in the year of our Lord, one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven, Between Matthew Figures and Mary, Figures his wife, of the County of Southampton and State of North Carolina, of the one part, and William Barry, Esq. and C. Barry, orphans of Thomas Barry dec^d. of the other part, of the County and state aforesaid, Witnesseth that the said Matthew Figures & Mary his wife, for and in consideration, of the sum of two hundred thirty pounds, current money of Virginia, to them in hand paid, by the said William Barry & C. Barry, the receipt whereof the said Matthew Figures & Mary his wife do hereby acknowledge, have granted bargain'd & sold, alien and confirm, unto the said William Barry, C. Barry, their heirs and assigns forever, one certain tract or parcel of land, situated lying and being in the County of Southampton and state of Virginia, containing three hundred Acres by survey, bearing date the seventeenth day of March one thousand seven hundred and eighty six — one hundred and ninety two Acres being formerly patented the residue never before granted, and bounded as followeth to wit, Beginning at a white oak a corner of John Clarks, thence along his line, North eighty degrees west seventy six poles to a small hemlock tree, thence South fifty nine degrees west, ninety seven Poles to a white oak stone South sixteen poles to an Elm, in Abbits swamp, thence down the run of the same swamp two hundred and fifty poles to an ash a corner of Benjamin Stephens land, thence along his line North seventy three degrees east, one hundred and eighty four poles to a lightwood post, a corner of the late late of Samuel Westbrooke jun^r dec^d thence along the line of the said land, North sixty four Poles to a Red Oak, thence North sixty two degrees west two hundred Poles
