 one horse, namely, Cair, Henry, Jordan, & Henry, To have and to hold
 the said bargained premises, unto the said Sam^l Barham, his heirs
 Executors, Administrators and assigns forever, and I the said Joel Barham
 for myself, my heirs, Executors, Administrators, the said bargained premises
 unto the said Sam^l Barham his heirs, Executors, Administrators. I do
 signify against all persons shall and will warrant and defend
