This Indenture made this fourteenth day of October in
 the year of our Lord, one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven
 between Jacob Barrett and Mary his wife of the County of Southamp-
 ton, and state of Virginia of the one part, and William Bryant
 of the County and State aforesaid of the other part witnesseth, that
 the said Jacob Barrett, and Mary his wife for and in Consideration of the
 sum of eighty four pounds, current money of Virginia to him in hand
 paid by the said William Bryant, before the sealing and delivery of these
 presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged to be fully satisfied
 and paid, hath granted, bargained, sold, aliened, conveyed and doth by these presents grant
 bargain, and sell, unto the said William Bryant, a tract or parcel of land
 lying and being in the County of Southampton, situated in the lower end of
 Southampton, containing by estimation eighty acres be the same more
 or less, and bounded as follows to wit: Beginning at a pine a corner of
 William Bryant's land in the County line, thence along the said County
 line to a black gum standing in the mouth of a slash, thence along the
 run of the said slash to a pine a corner tree in the head of the said slash
 thence along a line of marked trees to People of Spring in Etern Cove's line,
 thence along the said line to a pine a corner in Etern Cove's line, thence
 along the said line to the beginning, It being part of a patent granted
 to Robert Gilliam To hold the said land premises therein or thereunto
 with the appurtenances unto the said William Bryant his heirs and
 assigns forever, and also the reversion & reversions remainder & remain-
 rents and surveys of all and singular the said premises, and also all the
 right, title, Interest, property, claim & demand of them the said Jacob
 Barrett and Mary his wife for themselves, their heirs, Executors &
 doth covenant grant and agree to and with the said William Bryant
 that the said William Bryant his heirs Executors &c shall and lawfully
 may from henceforth hereafter, quietly and peaceably, have hold possess
 possess and enjoy the said land and premises above mentioned, and
 sufficiently have and keep harmless of our firm and true and
 incumbrances whatsoever by them the said Jacob Barrett
