

This Indenture made this sixth day of October in the year
 of our Lord, one thousand, seven hundred and Ninety seven; Between
 Charles Birosong, James Barnes & Robert Wick of Southampton County
 and state of Virginia Commissioners of the one part, and Lion Hill of the said
 County & State of the other part, witnesseth, that whereas the said Charles
 Birosong, James Barnes & Robert Wick, Commissioners, agreeably to
 an order of Southampton Court, dated November 1796, appointed to
 lay off a Tract in the Woods of Ruben Hill (dec'd) her donee, on the
 lands whereof her husband, deceased & professed, make sale of the same,
 to wit, two thirds of the said land, & the remainder of the same at
 public Auction after giving due notice, upon twelve months credit,
 and make conveyance thereof - divide the product of the said sale equally
 among the children of Ruben Hill dec'd (namely Lion Hill, Benjamin Hill,
 James Hill, William Hill, Susanna Worrell and Elizabeth Hill)

Now This Indenture Witnesseth that the said Charles Birosong &
 James & Robert Wick, Commissioners, for and in consideration of the sum
 of two hundred and twenty five pounds, current money of Virginia to them
 in hand paid by the said Lion Hill, at and before the sealing and delivering hereof
 the receipt, is hence acknowledged, hath granted, Bargained, sold aliened,
 confirmed, and by these presents, doth fully and absolutely grant, Bargain
 Sell, alien and Confer, unto the said Lion Hill his heirs or assigns, one
 certain tract or parcel of land, lying & being in the County aforesaid on the
 south side of Anthony River, and bounded as follows: Beginning at a
 markerum in Rushing Branch, near the County line, thence along a line of
 marked trees, near a west Course to a white oak, thence along a line of mark'd
 trees to a highwood Post, a corner of said Hills & John Marks, thence along a line
 of mark'd trees, near a north east Course to a white oak, a corner tree, thence
 along a line of mark'd trees near a North Course to a white oak, near Pocahontas
 thence along said Road to a pine in the side of Rushing Branch, thence down
 said Branch to a white oak a corner tree between the said Hill & Benjamin
 Whitfield & Richard Drew, thence down said Branch to a mark'd pine, thence
 down said Branch, along a line of mark'd trees to the beginning. By which
 two hundred and twenty acres, be the same more or less, together with all
 Houses & Buildings thereon, with the reversion & reversions, remainders, and re-
 mainders, rents and profits, thereof, and every part and parcel thereof with the
 appurtenances - To have and to hold the said land & premises unto the said
 Lion Hill his heirs and assigns forever, (according to the decree of said Court
 to the only proper use of him & the said Lion Hill his heirs and assigns)
 forever, and the said Charles Birosong, James Barnes & Robert Wick
 Commissioners, for themselves, their Executors & Administrators and
 agree to the said Lion Hill his Heirs and Assigns, that the above named
 premises is clear of all incumbrances according to the decree of said Court
