This Indenture made this fifteenth day of May, in the year of our Lord
one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven, between Moses Johnson
and Elizabeth his wife of the County of Southampton, of the one part, and
Benjamin Blunt of the said County of the other part witnesseth that for and
in consideration of the sum of twenty pounds ten shillings, Virginia currency
to them in hand paid by the said Blunt, the receipt whereof they the said Moses
Johnson & Elizabeth his wife, do hereby acknowledge, have granted bargained
and sold, and by these presents do grant bargain and sell, unto the said Benjamin
Blunt and to his heirs forever, one certain tract or parcel of Land, lying & being
in the County of Southampton, and containing by estimation, twenty three
acres, and more or less, to wit: beginning at a pine a corner tree of Na-
than Poles and Benjamin Blunt's land, in Moses Johnson's line, thence along
a line of marked trees, to wit: three oaks Johnson's land, North twenty degrees
west forty five feet to a white oak a corner tree in Moses Johnson's & Nathan
Poles lines by the sides of a small branch, near the said Johnson's Plantation
thence down the main Course of the run of the said branch, to Roses swamp
thence down the run of said swamp, to a large Poplar tree by the side of said
swamp, thence along a line of marked trees to a cedar pine, a corner tree in
the said Johnsons & Blunt's line, thence South twenty degrees East to a white
oak, another corner tree, in said lines, thence to the beginning, with accu-
ses, liches, Woods, Ways, waters & water Courses, privileges, heredita-
ments, and appurtenances, thereto in anywise belonging, or in any wise appur-
taining. To have and to hold the said granted land and premises to
the said Benjamin Blunt and to his heirs forever, and to the heirs of the said Benjamin Blunt his heirs &
assigns forever, and the said Moses Johnson & Elizabeth his wife for
themselves their heirs executors or administrators, with these presents con-
firmed, and will forever defend the title of the said granted land and premises
