 post, in John Windham's line, thence North along the said Wind-  
 ham's line, to a corner pine in said Windham's line, thence West along  
 the said Windham's line to a red Oak in said line, thence North along the  
 said John Windham's line, to a small pine, a corner in Weller Rogers line  
 thence east along the said Rogers line, to a corner lighwood post in  
 John Suckins line, thence S<sup>E</sup> along the said Suckins line to a corner  
 pine in Thomas Woods line, thence N<sup>E</sup> West along the said Woods line  
 to a corner which oak is in the head of the Horsepen swamp aforesaid  
 thence along the various Courses of the head of the said swamp to  
 the beginning the reversion Previsions, residing in or administered  
 rents & profits thereof, are all the estate right title, Interest  
 use, trust, possession, property, claim, and demands whatsoever

 said Robert Booth, his heirs and assigns, against all and every  
 man and persons whatsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same  
 and will warrant and procure our seal by these presents, In
