This Indenture made this 18th day of December in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven, between Nathaniel Doyles and Mary his wife of Southampton County of the one part, and Nathaniel Cobb of the County aforesaid of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Nathaniel Doyles for and in consideration of the just and full sum of thirty pounds current money of Virginia, by the said Nathaniel Cobb, to them in hand paid, as follows Viz^t, twenty pounds at a before the executing and delivery of these presents, and the other ten pounds on or before the first day of December next, enacting the date hereof, the receipt whereof the said Nathaniel Doyles & Mary his wife do hereby acknowledge them selves therewith to be fully and entirely satisfied & contented that they the said Nathaniel Doyles & Mary his wife have given and conveyed, sold aliened set over & delivered & by these presents to grant, bargain sell set over & deliver release & confirm unto the said Nathaniel Cobb, his heirs and assigns forever, a certain tract plantation tract or parcel of Land, containing by estimation one hundred and more or less Acres lying and being, in the County of Southampton Parish of St. Andrew being a part of a Part of land, that Christ the beloved, did & does & shall & ought to give
